

- 8.4 Attendance of all practices is compulsory. Missing a practice without a valid excuse in writing from the learner's parents may result in the learner being suspended from participation in one (1) inter-school league fixture.
- 8.5 Appropriate kit/uniform will be worn to practices.
- 8.6 The correct match kit/uniform will be worn to inter-school league fixtures.
- 8.7 Learners travelling to an away fixture will travel in full school uniform, unless other arrangements have been made.
- 8.8 Sports and other kit must be carried in an appropriate school sport bag.
- 8.9 Learners playing in home league fixtures may arrive at the venue in their appropriate sports kit/uniform.

9. Accommodation of Religious or Cultural Rights (refer to Religious Policy)

Parents must apply for a deviation from the standard school rules if such rules are in conflict with or infringe on any religious right of the learner.

This application must be in writing and must identify the specific rule/s that is/are offensive to the learner's religious right/s as contained in the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa.

Each case will be evaluated on its own merits and provided with a sanction justified for that specific case.

**List of the possible disciplinary sanctions
to be applied for Grade 1, 2, 3 and 4 offences, respectively**

Corrective actions/sanctions are carried out by the individual teacher and may include the following:

Grade 1 Offences	Recommended Corrective Sanctions
1. Academic: Books/work materials left at home; homework-not done on time/copied. 2. Extra-mural activity: Non-attendance at practices and matches (without a valid excuse to teachers/coach) 3. Personal conduct in classroom/on playground: Inappropriate displays of affection between learners; late arrival for class; uncooperative behaviour; discourteous behaviour/insolence/temper tantrum; foul language; defacing desks/walls/books/cases with graffiti; eating/chewing in class; littering and cell phone ringing. 4. Dress code: Untidiness/unkept appearance; school dress code not followed.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Verbal reprimand • Demerit • Written punishment • Detention • Subtracting marks (homework) • Temporary confiscation until the end of school term (e.g. uniform, jewellery, cell phones, bags, and cases) • Removing graffiti from bags and cases at break • Written notification • Warning letter

Grade 2: Offences	Recommended Corrective Sanctions
1. Plagiarism of any work or cheating/attempted cheating in class test/assignment.	Nought for test, warning letter and detention.
2. Damage to property/possession of other learners' property.	Repair/replacement, warning letter, detention, disciplinary hearing and possible expulsion.
3. Defiance/disregarding of any authority figure's Instructions.	Suspension from class, warning letter and detention.
4. Detention – non attendance.	Making up missed detention, warning letter and an information hearing.
5. Disregarding test/examination procedures.	Warning letter, detention and contact parents.
6. Disruptive/uncooperative in class.	Identification of culprit/s and grade teacher to organize corrective measures, disciplinary hearing and possible expulsion.
7. Behaviour that is disruptive to teaching and learning.	Warning letter and detention, disciplinary hearing and possible expulsion.
